Job Brief:

As part of the Field Engineer Team your core role will be operating the companies service provision both offshore and onshore to a high standard. Operations are ad-hoc and often at short notice, and so flexibility in this regard is a key attribute. When not on operations, there is a requirement to perform a number of duties both in the office and at other locations as outlined below. For every two days of work, one day of leave is accrued and can then be taken as preferred once approval has been given.

Specific training on EV's existing product lines will be provided as required, and further training will be provided as future product lines are released. The successful candidate will have the opportunity to be at the forefront of class leading, innovative products. They will be expected to exceed client expectations regarding service quality and assist other members of the team in achieving this goal.

Role and Responsibilities:

- Abiding by and maintaining adherence to Company Quality, Health, Safety and Environmental policies and procedures at all times.
- Offshore and Onshore operation of Company's service provision, including UKCS & overseas remote locations as required.
- Attendance of SIT or FAT as required at Company or client nominated site.
- Attendance of meetings with clients and service companies as required
- Equipment preparation prior to equipment mobilization.
- Inspection and review of equipment on return to EV facility.
- Company workshop based tasks in the support of onshore or offshore operations.
- Preparation of required documentation including but not limited to manifests, delivery notes, operating procedures, risk assessments, operational reports and service reports.
- Pre-job meeting with client and post-job wash-up meetings, solely or accompanies depending on grade including HAZOP or equivalent.
- Recommending and getting approval for new or revised operating procedures and/or equipment improvements or Products.
- Behaving in a professional, courteous and suitable manner at all times.
- Abiding by and adhering to the Company's Code of Business Conduct.
